Phase one will be the remodeling of the current building we purchased to create a dining room, kitchen, recreation area, office and storage.

Phase two will involve the construction of an addition to the building that will house the lodge room and storage.

This will be done by connecting the two buildings with a hallway. By doing it this way, we can build a wood rather than steel structure at significant savings.

On March, 29th, several brothers assembled at the new building on Smith St. to begin phase one. There were several walls that needed to be torn down to make a larger dining room and expand the room that will be the kitchen.

We accomplished a great deal on that day and have a work schedule as follows

We are bidding out the work we can't do ourselves to several contractors.

We should have most of the bids by the stated meeting in May. We will vote to grant contracts to these contractors once final approval comes back from Grand Lodge on our design.

When we start on the new addition we intend to have a cornerstone ceremony and when the building is complete a lodge rededication. We have a lot of work ahead, but when we're done, I think you will all be proud of the new building.
